

The congregational meeting will begin at Noon. To join the meeting, please do the following a few minutes before the scheduled start time for the meeting:

- Enter the meeting ID: 958 4412 1690 and click "Join" B)
- C) When prompted, enter the meeting passcode: 856373
- D) Click "Join Meeting"
- When prompted, click either "Join with Video" or "Join Without Video". E)
  - You'll be able to see the meeting either way, this determines whether or not you can be seen by others.
- F) The meeting host will admit you.

Vaccinations are becoming available in Hamilton Co. People in the 1A population have priority. Go to <a href="https://">https://</a> www.hamiltoncountyhealth.org/covid19/ and fill out an online registration form for the vaccine. You will receive an e-mail confirmation of registration. If you can not register online, the telephone number for Hamilton County Health is 513.946.7800. For those who live in the City of Cincinnati, Springdale or Norwood, contact your local health department.

In order to help us make plans for in-person worship and other in-person programming, Rev. Ben and the Session invite you to let us know if and when you receive your second dose of the Covid vaccine. This is totally optional, but will help us understand how close we are to being back together.
